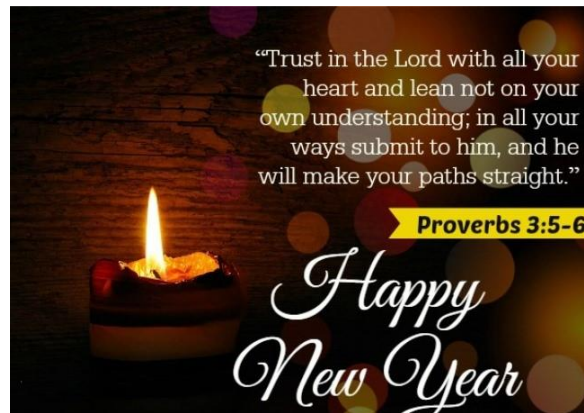

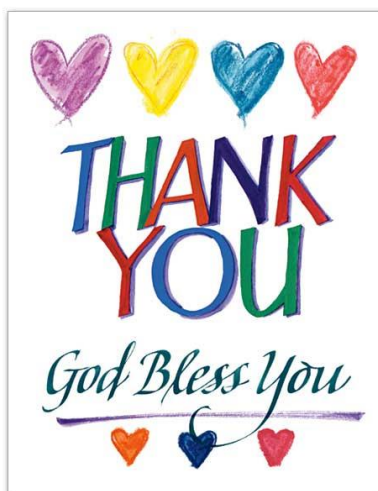
CAROL/HYMM SING
