Introduction Worship: Jesus makes the unclean clean, the diseased whole, the oppressed free he does it with a word, he does it from afar, he does it personally. Believe him.
I. He touched disease (vv.1-4) The unclean doesn't defile Jesus; his touch heals
II. He spoke healing (vv.5-13) Distance doesn't stop Jesus; his word heals
III. He took our illnesses (vv.14-17) Humanity doesn't overwhelm Jesus; he bore our diseases
"Go and tell John what you have seen and heard: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the poor have good news preached to them." (Luke 7:22)
