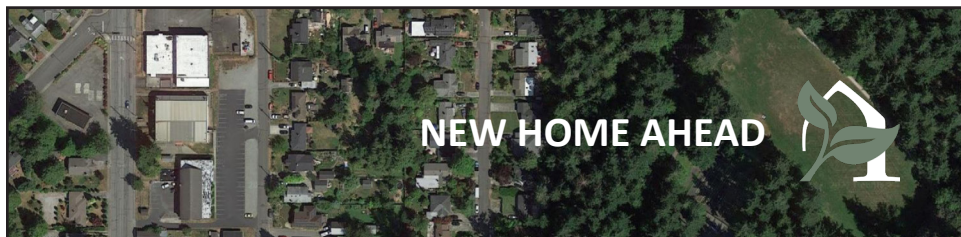

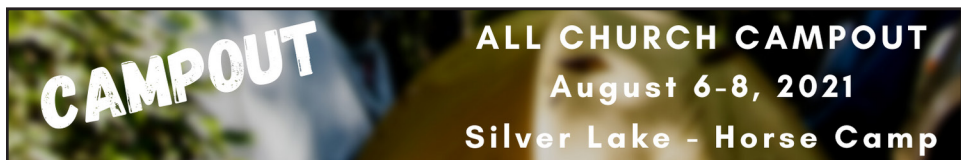
Prayer @ Grace
