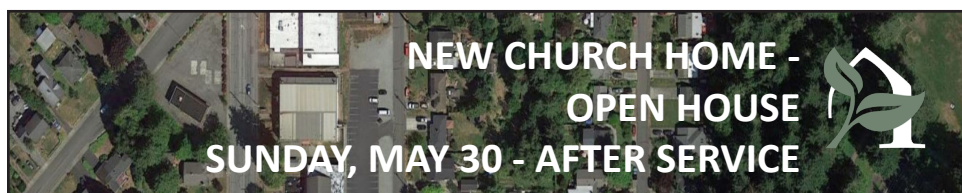

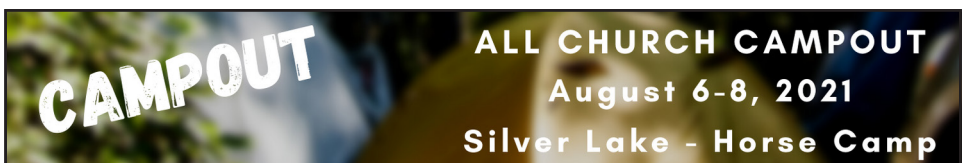
Outdoor Fellowship - You're Invited!
