

Introduction

I. Behold the Man! Crucify him, crucify him!

- II. You will not speak to me? I have authority to crucify!
- III. Behold Your King! Away with him, crucify him!

"For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Corinthians 5:21)
