

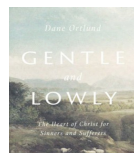
Join us for an all church BBQ, immediately following our Sunday Service here at our new location.
